Getting on board with the ASHADEEP SCHOOL BUS! Ashadeep Giving Tree



With the beginning of Advent St. Patrick's Justice and Service Commission has once more set up the Giving Tree for Ashadeep by the St. Joseph's Altar. This year there is an urgent need to raise funds for a new school bus as we did in 2012. This bus, whose capacity is normally 18, now carries as many as 70 children on each of two pick up and delivery trips; the smaller car, which usually seats 10, is carrying 30. Some children have to get up at 5:00 AM in order to allow for the second pick up. At the end of the day, children are waiting for an hour at school before the trip home. The rented bus has broken down several times Advent, a time of hope and promise, to help the children of Ashadeep.

Redevelopment of 131 McCaul St!

You may have seen the signs outside around the Church Office, by the Day Care entrance and on St. Patrick Street about the development of the lands at 131 McCaul Street. You might recall that a couple of years ago, the Redemptorists informed the parish that we were entering into dialogue with potential developers for the redevelopment of the property which is owned by the Redemptorist Community (not by the parish). Currently, the property is being used by the parish and by the Catholic Settlement House Day Care. As we look at the development of a condominium, we are still committed to the development of new space for our Parish Offices, new ministry facilities as well as space for a Day Care Centre. As the posters indicate, we are only at the phase of consultation with the local community. If you reside close by, you will be invited to those opportunities to learn about the project. We are grateful to Tribute Communities for their work with us to further this project along. As I'm sure you can appreciate, we are **far** from getting a shovel in the ground. But we wanted to update you on this project.
