Wednesday April 3, 2019 12:45pm – 2pm

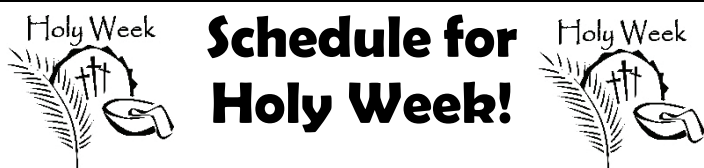
