Bishop Jon Hansen was formerly a pastor of Our Lady of Victory Parish in Inuvik, was appointed by Pope Francis in December and succeeds Bishop Mark Hagemoen, who was appointed Bishop of Saskatoon. Bishop Jon Hansen was born and raised in Alberta before joining the Redemptorists and being ordained a priest in 2003. The Diocese of MacKenzie-Fort Smith, with 32 parishes and missions, covers much of Canada's North.
