# Parking in the Parking Lot

In this big city, it's always a concern to have available parking for public events. We are fortunate to have an updated parking lot across the street for the use of the Parish. A few years ago, we issued parking passes to identify vehicles that use the lot, however, those parking passes reflect an old system of tracking vehicles and are no longer valid.

Parking is available for parishioners who are on the property for an event. We ask that when you are finished at the Church, please leave the parking lot, as we need to make room for the next Mass or next event. **Please do not leave your vehicle in the parking lot if you are not on the property.** 

Many of you have seen Fr. Santo outside at times directing traffic. Unfortunately, we have had to often ticket and tow vehicles that park and leave the property when we require the parking lot for Weddings, Funerals or Masses on Wednesdays and Sundays.

The Gate to the Lot is locked when we need to reserve the lot for special events (Weddings and Funerals), and as we get closer to winter, we will need to lock it to prevent people from parking during snow storms at night so our plough can effectively keep the lot clean. Don't get stuck being locked in by accident! The signage in the Parking Lot is clear about our expectations.
