ROAD and TRACK CONSTRUCTION on McCAUL STREET

The City of Toronto and TTC will be doing major construction on McCaul St from Mid April to Mid July.

From April 15 - 23, there will be work north of Baldwin St. towards Orde St., but should not interrupt access to the Church during Holy Week and Easter.


However, beginning on Easter Tuesday, April 23, for 6 weeks, McCaul Street will be closed from Dundas to College. We will still be able to enter the Church, as pedestrian access is still available from Dundas St. *As well, Wheeltrans will continue to operate and drop off passengers in front of the Parish Office at 131 McCaul.* Fr. Santo has made arrangements with the City to allow for the needed access for all pedestrians and Wheeltrans passengers during the first 10 days of construction. However, during this period there will be NO ACCESS to the PARKING LOT on McCaul St. By May 2nd, the City and TTC will complete the work of track replacement and sidewalk replacement south of D'Arcy Street, allowing us to have access again for parking, walking and Wheeltrans in the front of the Church.

Therefore, the major days during the 10 day closure that we will have NO PARKING are: WED April 24, WEEKEND of April 27-28, and WED May 1.

After the parking lot is been reopened, it will only be accessible from Dundas St, going north on McCaul. Please make your plans accordingly during this closure of McCaul St. Thank you for your consideration and cooperation.
