Following our brief introduction of this Letter in Advent, the Liturgy Committee would like to respond to Pope Francis' invitation and offer an evening of discussion and reflection on this most important liturgy wherein Jesus invites us to eat his body and to drink his blood in order to become one with him. Thus, by increasing our understanding we may have *full, conscious and active participation* in the liturgy.
