## The Commemoration of all the Faithful Departed (All Souls' Day)

Each year on this day, the faithful are encouraged to remember the dead and pray for the souls in purgatory. As November 2<sup>nd</sup> falls on a Monday this year, in addition to the regular 12:10pm mass, a special solemn mass will be celebrated at 7:00pm.

This year, due to the pandemic and the risk of passing on the virus through touching surfaces, there will not be able to have a "Book of the Names of the Dead" available for people to write the names of their deceased loved ones. Those who wish to remember their loved ones are asked to write the names of the deceased on a slip of paper and place them in a special prayer box that will be provided. We will remember the deceased during the masses on All Souls day, and throughout the month of November.

Please note that there will <u>not be papers</u>, <u>pens or pencils</u> available in the church for this <u>purpose</u>. Please write the names on a sheet of paper <u>at home</u>, and simply bring them with you and place them in the box that will be provided.

### **Church Hours**

The church will be open one hour prior to the beginning of mass. One exception will be for those who wish to go to Confession on Saturday afternoons between 3 and 4pm. The church may not be left open, unsupervised, at this time.

## **Parish Office**

The parish office is open Tuesday – Friday 9am-12pm and 1pm-4pm by appointment only! The office will remain closed on Mondays. To make an appointment please call us at 416-598-3269 or email the parish office at secretary@stpatrickstoronto.ca Please do not come to the office without an appointment. Only one person would be allowed to enter in the office at one time because of social distancing. Due to municipal by-law, and the Archdiocese of Toronto masks or face coverings are mandatory. ## **Church Capacity**

Please note the maximum capacity at St Patrick's, after factoring in physical distancing, is 162 people. Parish will use "first come, first seated" seating system. Doors will open one hour before Mass begins. Once all spaces are full, the doors will have to be closed. The church cannot be left unattended. Doors will open one hour before Mass and close immediately after Mass for sanitizing. Parking lot is open for Mass/Confession only and the gate will be locked once Mass is over.

### **Out of the Cold**

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, we will not be serving dinner and providing accommodations to our guests at St. Patrick's for the 2020-21 season. However, to help as many homeless guests and people facing food insecurity as possible, we will be preparing meals at St. Patrick's which will then be served by two agencies (Good Shepherd Ministries on Queen St. and the St. Felix Centre on Augusta) at their locations by local staff. It is estimated that we will need to provide meals to feed approximately 500 people each week.

St. Patrick's Out of the Cold operates through the kindness of generous donors. To make a financial contribution, envelopes for Out of the Cold are available in the church and may be deposited with the offertory collection at masses on Sundays or Wednesdays. Donations may also be placed in any the four Prayer Intention boxes along the counters at the back of the church or sent to the parish through the mail. Please make cheques payable to "St. Patrick's Church — Out of the Cold Program". For your added convenience, you may now donate by credit card through the parish office. An appointment is required.
