The Commemoration of all the Faithful Departed (All Souls' Day)

Each year on this day, the faithful are encouraged to remember the dead and pray for the souls in purgatory. As November 2nd falls on a Monday this year, in addition to the regular 12:10pm mass, a special solemn mass will be celebrated at 7:00pm.

This year, due to the pandemic and the risk of passing on the virus through touching surfaces, there will not be able to have a *"Book of the Names of the Dead"* available for people to write the names of their deceased loved ones. Those who wish to remember their loved ones are asked to write the names of the deceased on a slip of paper and place them in a special prayer box that will be provided. We will remember the deceased during the masses on All Souls day, and throughout the month of November.

Please note that there will <u>not be papers, pens or pencils</u> <u>available in the church for this purpose</u>. Please write the names on a sheet of paper <u>at home</u>, and simply bring them with you and place them in the box that will be provided.

Out of the Cold

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, we will not be serving dinner and providing accommodations to our quests at St. Patrick's for the 2020-21 season. However, to help as many homeless guests and people facing food insecurity as possible, we will be preparing meals at St. Patrick's which will then be served by two agencies (Good Shepherd Ministries on Queen St. and the St. Felix Centre on Augusta) at their locations by local staff. It is estimated that we will need to provide meals to feed approximately 500 people each week. St. Patrick's Out of the Cold operates through the kindness of generous donors. To make a financial contribution, envelopes for Out of the Cold are available in the church and may be deposited with the offertory collection at masses on Sundays or Wednesdays. Donations may also be placed in any the four Prayer Intention boxes along the counters at the back of the church or sent to the parish through the mail. Dear Parishioners,

In September, I announced in the weekly bulletin, that the parish, with the support of the Parish Pastoral Council, was seeking a qualified, experienced, part-time *Director of Music and Liturgy* who would assist in coordinating all aspects of the liturgical life of the parish. Approximately 20 resumés were received and from among those, four were chosen for interviews.

I am pleased to announce that Dr. Robin Williams has been selected and will assume this position beginning November 1st. He has a wide breadth of education and experience in the field of sacred music. Since January 2020, Robin was hired as the organist for the 5:05pm and 7:00pm Wednesday Devotion masses, and more recently for the Saturday 5:00pm mass.

Robin is from Bay Bulls, Newfoundland. For eleven years, he served as Organist and Director of Music at St. Teresa's Parish, a parish served by the Redemptorists in St. John's Newfoundland. He is currently a secondary school teacher with the Toronto Catholic District School Board and specializes in choral music.

Educationally, Robin holds a *Doctorate in Sacred Music* from the Pontifical Institute of Sacred Music, Rome, Italy; a *Master of Music in Sacred Music* from the Catholic University of America, Washington, D.C.; and a both a *Bachelor of Music* and *Bachelor of Music Education* from Memorial University, St. John's, Newfoundland. His graduate work including his doctoral thesis, involved intense study of the ecclesiastical legislation pertaining to liturgy and music.

I am pleased to welcome Robin as a member of our staff and parish pastoral team, and am confident that he will help to ably guide and develop not only the program of liturgical music, but all the liturgical ministries of the parish.
