### Marriage

Engaged couples from St. Patrick's Parish should make an appointment with the Pastor one year prior to their wedding.

Adults wishing to be baptized or received into the Catholic Church should contact the parish office. Sessions begin in the Fall.



## **Church Capacity**

The Provincial Government announced changes to the restrictions on places of worship currently in the Grey Lockdown Zone. As of March 15, 2021 churches in Toronto and Peel Region were permitted to open at 15% capacity. This includes anyone assisting with the service (priest, volunteers, etc.). Please note the maximum capacity at St Patrick's, after factoring in physical distancing, is 128 people. Parish will use "first come" seating system. Doors will open one hour before Mass begins. Once all spaces are full, the doors will have to be closed. The church cannot be left unattended. Doors will open one hour before Mass and close immediately after Mass for sanitizing. Parking lot is open for Mass/Confession only and the gate will be locked once Mass is over.

You can mail in your Unannounced Mass request or drop it off at the office at 151 McCaul St. using the mail slot on the front door, or you can drop it off at the back of the church in the drop box.
