Church Capacity

The Government of Ontario announced that the province will enter Step One of its re-opening plan on Friday, June 11 at 12:01 a.m. We are excited to share that thanks to an amendment to the provincial government's re-opening plan, the Archdiocese of Toronto will return to in-person Mass this weekend. The June 11 re-opening is providential, as it is the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and mass will be celebrated at 12:10pm. Please check our website in the coming days to see when in-person Masses will resume. Worship Safe protocols will continue to be in place at this time. Please note the maximum capacity at St Patrick's, after factoring in physical distancing, is 128 people. Parish will use "first come" seating system. Doors will open one hour before Mass begins. Once all spaces are full, the doors will have to be closed. The church cannot be left unattended. Doors will open one hour before Mass and close immediately after Mass for sanitizing. Parking lot is open for Mass/Confession only and the gate will be locked once Mass is over.
