The Eucharistic Prayer

The central prayer of the mass, which includes the consecration, begins after the offertory when priest greets the assembly, "The Lord be with you" and ends when the assembly responds "Amen" after the priest has prayed "Through him, with him, in him ...

The eight parts of this prayer are referred to by the first Latin words of that part. Those parts of the prayer in which the assembly is called to sing are as follows: Dominus vobiscum = The Lord be with you; Mysteruim fedei = The Mystery of faith; Per Ipsum: Through Him (Amen).

For about 30 years now, St. Patrick's Out of the Cold Program has been serving meals and offering overnight shelter for the most vulnerable in downtown Toronto during the winter season. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic and the loss of funding from the City of Toronto for floor security, we will not be serving dinner and providing accommodations to our guests at St. Patrick's for the 2021-22 season. However, to help as many homeless guests and people facing food insecurity as possible, once again this year we will be preparing meals at St. Patrick's which will then be served by two agencies (Good Shepherd Ministries on Queen St. and St. Felix on Augusta) at their locations by local staff. The program is run by committed volunteers and relies on donations from businesses and individuals. As usual, it has been decorated with small gifts, including rosaries made by some of the children and priests of Ashadeep. Instead of buying a gift for someone, you can make a donation in their name and take an ornament to give as representative of the gift.

There are envelopes in which you can place your donation, cheque or cash, and these can be placed in the boxes at the back of the church or in the collection during Mass.
