World Day of the Sick

February 11 was instituted by St. Pope John Paul II, as World Day of the Sick, so that the faithful might offer special prayers for those suffering from illnesses. World Day of the Sick, which is held on the memorial of Our Lady of Lourdes, is also an opportunity for those who serve in health care ministry to reflect on their role in providing spiritual comfort and healing to those who are sick as well as to those who work in the health care profession. On Friday February 11, 2022 during the 12:10 pm Mass here at St. Patrick's Parish, we will celebrate the Sacrament of the Sick for anyone who wishes to be Anointed. Pre-Registration for the reception of the Sacrament is required to allow the Pastoral Team to adequately prepare for this celebration. The Pastoral Care Ritual outlines those who are eligible to receive the Sacrament. "The Letter of James states that the sick are to be anointed in order to raise them up and save them. Great care and concern should be taken to see that those of the faithful whose health is seriously impaired by sickness or old age receive this Sacrament. A prudent or reasonably sure judgement, without scruple, is sufficient for deciding on the seriousness of an illness. A sick person may be anointed before surgery whenever serious illness is the reason for the surgery. Elderly people may be anointed if they become notably weakened even though no serious illness is present. Sick children may be anointed if they have sufficient use of reason to be strengthened by this sacrament. The priest is the proper minister of the anointing of the sick." One year advance notice is required for marriages. Do not book reception halls etc. before contacting the church.
