Parents wishing to have a child baptized must contact the parish office to register. Baptism are usually at Mass on the first Sunday of the month.

R.C.I.A.

Adults wishing to be baptized or received into the Catholic Church must contact the parish office. Sessions begin in the Fall.

The cantor intones the Refrain, after which a repetition of it and all subsequent Refrains are sung by the Assembly.

After the Dismissal

Unless remaining for private prayer, the Assembly, having heard the Dismissal (or 'Ite Missa Est') departs the church in procession flowing out into the main aisle behind the priest as he passes by. To go forth in this manner, having been spiritually nourished through the Eucharist, is a powerful sign of acceptance of the mission to live according to the Gospel.

Mass of Chrism is a special Mass, held in Toronto at St. Michael's Cathedral for the priests of the Archdiocese of Toronto, on the Tuesday of Holy Week, April 12 at 11:00 a.m. At the Chrism Mass the holy oils used in the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, Holy Orders and Sacrament of the Sick are blessed and supplied to the local parishes for use.

Couples who want to marry at St. Patrick's Parish, the bride or groom (Catholic Party) must live within the parish boundaries or be registered in the parish and attend on a weekly basis for at least 6 months.
