Permanent Diaconate Ordination 2022

On Saturday June 18, 20 men were ordained permanent deacons in service to the Archdiocese of Toronto. Their ministry begins in Toronto's St. Michael's Cathedral Basilica, but will extend far beyond the walls of any church. The assignments for these new deacons reflect the diverse ways the Church is engaged in society: serving the poor in soup kitchens, like St. Francis Table and Ripples of Kindness, and in food and clothing banks; accompanying the sick and dying in hospitals; and assisting those with intellectual disabilities. Other deacons will support former prisoners through the Friends of Dismas ministry and provide pastoral care to itinerant workers through the Apostleship of the Seas. The Mass and ordination ceremony was presided by Cardinal Thomas Collins, Archbishop of Toronto.

Sacrament of Marriage
