

Out of the Cold

St. Patrick's Out of the Cold program seeks to respond to the immediate need for food for our vulnerable population each weekend from November to April. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic and lack of funding from the City of Toronto, St Patrick's Out of the Cold will not be serving dinner or providing accommodations to our guests for the 2022/2023 season. However, to help as many homeless guests and people facing food insecurity as possible, we will be preparing meals at St. Patrick's which will then be served by two agencies at their locations by local staff: Good Shepherd Ministries on Queen Street, and St. Felix on Augusta Avenue. We need a few volunteers each weekend to help the cooking team prepare and pack the meals, clean the kitchen area, etc. if you are interested in becoming a volunteer, please fill out the short survey at www.surveymonkey.com/r/WRJ2WP6, or contact our volunteer coordinator, Anthony Romano, at ootc.volunteers@stpatrickstoronto.ca for more information. An orientation meeting for volunteers will be held in the parish hall on Sunday, October 30th at 2:00 pm.

The program relies on donations from businesses and individuals. If you would like to make a financial contribution, cheques can be made out to "St. Patrick's Church – Out of the Cold Program" and mailed to the parish office, or placed in specially marked envelopes available at the back of the church and dropped in the collection during Mass. Donations can also be made through the church website by clicking on 'Donate' and mentioning 'OOTC Program' in the comments section. Tax receipts are available for all donations at the end of the year.

Pakistan Floods

Devastating floods in Pakistan have displaced hundreds of thousands, at one point leaving a third of the country inundated with water. More than 1,500 people have died following record rainfall with 33 million throughout the country affected by this disaster.

Since June, Pakistan has experienced three times more rainfall than an average monsoon season. Flooding and landslides have destroyed homes, crops, health centres, roads and bridges.

There is an elevated risk of the spread of malaria, dengue fever and other diseases. Priorities include clean water, shelter and health care for those directly affected by this tragic situation.

The Archdiocese of Toronto will channel donations through Catholic partners (including Caritas Canada – Development and Peace as well as the Archdiocese of Karachi) to support relief efforts underway. Please note that these organizations are not subject to the government matching funds program.
