Communion This Is My Body

Assembly:

This Is My Body; given for your freedom.

This Is My Blood, which was shed for all mankind.

Take, all, and eat, 'til the day of my return.

Cantor or Schola sings initial refrain, after which the Assembly repeats it and sings all subsequent refrains; sing from heart while in communion procession without the hymnal.

The Ordinary of the Mass refers to the prayers belonging to the Assembly which remain the same at every mass. Namely, Kyrie eleison, Gloria in excelsis, Sanctus and Agnus Dei, as well as the Credo, and the Oratio Dominica (the Lord's Prayer) which we have not learned to sing ... yet.

The period of Ordinary Time after Epiphany is short, but the period after Pentecost, which is now upon us is long, lasting until the First Sunday of Advent. Therefore, we will sing two settings of the Ordinary, alternating each Sunday. This may be confusing for some at first, but you after a few Sundays, the variety will be refreshing each week.

The Gloria will remain the same, a chant setting in English. The other will alternate between a simple Gregorian chant setting (Latin) and an English setting, adapted from the German Mass of Franz Schubert.

Why all the Latin? In the Constitution on the Sacred Liturgy, Vatican II decreed, "The use of the Latin language, with due respect to particular law, is to be preserved ... (#36)". It was also a decree of the Council that "the faithful be able to ... sing in Latin the congregational parts of the Mass (#55)". More, "The Church acknowledges Gregorian chant as specially suited to the Roman liturgy: therefore, other things being equal, it should be given pride of place in liturgical services" (#116). Gregorian chant, by definition is in Latin. Very many reasons exist for this, but ultimately it is an expression of unity and universality among Catholics, and extends back to the fifth century, when the first basilicas were built in Rome, and the people of God gathered to worship, free of persecution, singing praises.
