Securities as a Charitable Gift Option

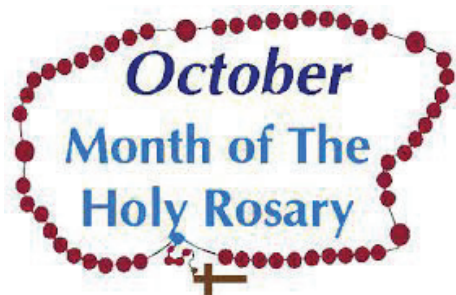
