

Vigil of Pentecost – Extended Form Saturday, May 18 at 5 o'clock

Our Blessed Lord, before ascending to Heaven, told the Apostles to gather in one place and wait and pray, and they would receive the Holy Spirit

Next Saturday, May 18 at 5 o'clock we will celebrate the Vigil of Pentecost and we too will gather to wait and pray

for the outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon us and on the whole world.

Just as the Easter Vigil contains an extended Liturgy of the Word, so does the Pentecost Vigil although you may not be familiar with it because it is so infrequently celebrated. *The liturgy lasts approximately 20 to 30 minutes longer than a usual Sunday Mass.*

So, turn to the Lord and ask him if he is calling you closer to him in prayer? Or are you longing to receive the Holy Spirit so that his gifts transform your life? If so, then consider keeping Vigil with us next Saturday at 5pm as we, like the Apostles along with his Blessed Mother, wait in prayer for the outpouring of that same Spirit who remains with us always.
