#### Communion You Are Near 695

Cantor or Choir sings the initial refrain, after which the Assembly repeats it and sings all subsequent refrains; sing from heart while in communion procession without the hymnal

In anticipation of the Triduum leading up to the Feast of Our Lady of Perpetual Help on <u>27 June</u>, one verse of the hymn **O Mother of Perpetual Help** will be sung by All as the ministers withdraw.

Join us Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday evening at 6:30pm for the Rosary & 7:00pm Mass to celebrate and honour Our Mother of Perpetual Help

This year's **Triduum in honour of Our Mother of Perpetual** begins next Tuesday. **Fr. Ray Earle**, our former associate pastor, will be here to preside and preach the first two days of the Triduum, the 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> of June. The theme for the first evening will be "*Praying with the Eyes of Mary*". The theme for the second evening will be "*Praying with the Heart of Mary*".

The third evening, Thursday June 27<sup>th</sup>, will be an opportunity to welcome **His Grace, Archbishop Francis Leo**, who will preside and preach on the Feast of Our Mother of Perpetual Help. A light reception with refreshments will follow in the parish hall.

This year, on all three nights, we will meditate on the **mysteries of the rosary** beginning shortly after 6:30. Although many are accustomed to praying the rosary on a regular basis, these evenings will be an opportunity to more deeply contemplate each mystery with the scriptures and singing. So, consider joining us at 6:30 each evening and bring your rosary beads. The Triduum Masses will follow the rosary at 7pm.

At each of the Triduum Masses, a collection will be taken during the Offertory to help support the Shrine ministry here at St. Patrick's. On the back counters there are Pink Envelopes for the Perpetual Help Novena Triduum. Your generosity is always very much appreciated.
