To ensure the reverent and proper handling of the Eucharist, we kindly ask those who would like to bring Holy Communion to the homebound speak with Fr. Tom before or after Mass rather than presenting a pyx in the Communion line to one of the Extraordinary Ministers of Communion. We would also like to keep a record of the names of those receiving Holy Communion at home, and who is bringing it to them. This practice helps us maintain the dignity of the Sacrament and ensures that proper procedures are followed in ministering to the homebound. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.

As we celebrate the Jubilee Year, the Parish Pastoral Council invites all parishioners to a special Jubilee Mass here at St. Patrick's Church. A reception will follow in the church hall, offering an opportunity for fellowship and celebration. All are welcome — come and be part of this special evening as we journey together as pilgrims of hope! \*Please note that this is a parish celebration and **not** one of the official Jubilee Masses at the designated pilgrimage churches in the Archdiocese of Toronto where plenary indulgences can also be received.

# Celebrate the Year of Jubilee and Elevation of Cardinal Leo — Regional Eucharistic Celebrations with Cardinal Leo & Auxiliary Bishops

All are welcome to attend Regional Masses that will be held throughout the Archdiocese of Toronto in the coming days.

There will be two groups of Masses – one Mass in each of the four regions of the archdiocese will launch the Jubilee Year and also provide an opportunity to give thanks for the elevation of Frank Cardinal Leo to the College of Cardinals. At these Eucharistic celebrations, Cardinal Leo will preside. Other celebrations will take place at the remaining pilgrim churches in each of the four regions of the archdiocese to launch the Jubilee Year. At these Eucharistic celebrations, the Auxiliary Bishop with pastoral responsibility for the region will preside.

Please note, for those interested in obtaining a Jubilee indulgence, requirements include receiving the Sacrament of Reconciliation, attending Mass and offering prayers for the intention of the Holy Father. Confessions will be offered at least one hour prior to all celebrations noted below – all Masses will begin at 7:00 p.m.

**Celebrations in the Central Region** will take place as follows:

**Wednesday, February 12, 2025** – St. Paul's Basilica, Toronto (Bishop Kasun to preside)

**Thursday, February 20, 2025**– St. Mary's Parish, Toronto (130Bathurst St.) (Bishop Kasun to preside)

**Tuesday, February 25, 2025** - St. Edward the Confessor Parish, North York (Cardinal Leo to preside)

## Sacrament of Marriage

Couples who want to marry at St. Patrick's Parish, or are planning a marriage outside of the Archdiocese of Toronto (eg. in another diocese within Canada, or in another country) are required to meet with one of the priests here at St. Patrick's and complete their preparations in the Archdiocese of Toronto. One of either the bride or groom (Catholic Party) must live within the parish boundaries, or, if living outside of the parish boundaries, must be registered in the parish and attend on a weekly basis. It is a policy of the Archdiocese of Toronto that one year's advance notice is required for marriages. It is important that couples do not book reception venues etc. before contacting the church. The parish boundaries of St. Patrick's are as follows: Lake Ontario to the South, College Street to the North, Spadina Ave. to the West, and Elizabeth Street & York Street to the East.
