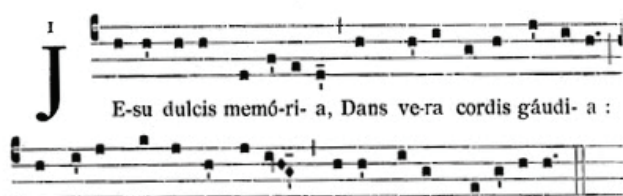

St. Patrick's Parish Jubilee Year Lenten Food Drive
