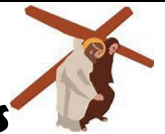

Mary's Way of the Cross

This week, as we pray the Stations of the Cross, we follow Jesus' journey through the eyes of his mother Mary. We reflect on her sorrow and grief and the 'sword that pierced her heart' as she walked with him to Calvary. We ask for Our Mother of Perpetual Help to intercede for us on our journey as disciples.



The Archdiocese of Toronto has partnered with Tip Tap Pay so that you can help support your parish with a simple tap. Simply tap and hold your payment card or smart device to the 'tiptap' device to give to your parish. That's it!

You can also receive a **tax receipt** for your 'tiptap' gift as well. After your first tap, **scan the parish QR Code right away** with your smart phone and register your payment card. You only need to register your card once. After your card has been registered, you will receive an end-of-year tax receipt for all of your 'tiptap' gifts. All 'tiptap' gifts prior to registering your card are not eligible for a tax receipt. Please note that tax receipts can only be given when an *actual payment card* is used, and *not* through a smartphone or other smart device.

Your card will be charged the amount indicated on the device each time you tap with your card. You can also tap the device multiple times to donate more to your parish. Your data is completely secure. The 'tiptap' device does not store any information and will shut down if the device is tampered with.

Touchless giving will support the essential work of our parish and we are grateful for your kindness! We are happy to provide parishioners who no longer carry cash or prefer to use digital giving as a way to further support our parish.

St. Patrick's Parish Jubilee Year Lenten Food Drive

In celebration of the Jubilee Year, we will be conducting a Lenten Food Drive. Our goal is to collect 400 pounds of food, and raise \$2,000 in cash that will be donated to the **Fort York Food Bank** located on College Street just west of Spadina Ave. Throughout Lent parishioners and visitors to all weekday and weekend masses are encouraged to donate items such as: peanut butter, pasta, or pasta sauce, any type of canned beans, fruit, fish vegetables, soup, stew, or chilli, bags of rice, 100% fruit juice in a can or box, boxed cereal, or oatmeal, baby food, or baby formula. Donation baskets will be provided at the back of the church so that your donations can be collected and immediately delivered to FYFB each week. Alternatively, a monetary donation can be made using the envelopes at the back of the church; please make cheques payable to "St. Patrick's Parish", indicating "Food Drive Donation" on the memo line.
