Once registered, you will receive an end-of-year tax receipt for your 'tiptap' gifts. All 'tiptap' gifts prior to registering are not eligible for a tax receipt. Please note that tax receipts can only be given when an actual payment card is used, and not through a mobile/wearable device.
