Pentecost Sunday

Next Sunday, June 7th, is Pentecost Sunday, the great Solemnity that celebrates the outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles to institute the Church, and which marks the end of the Easter Season.

Next Saturday evening is the Vigil of Pentecost – Once again this year, following a history that dates back to the early church, we will be celebrating a somewhat little-known but powerful liturgy which is an *extended form* of the usual Pentecost Vigil. Just like the Easter Vigil at the start of the season, this vigil at the conclusion of the Easter season includes additional Scripture readings that reflect the role of the Holy Spirit in the life of the Church. There will be four readings and four psalms prior to the epistle and Gospel.

The reason for this unique celebration of the Third Person of the Holy Trinity is that the coming of the Holy Spirit so moves the Church that the gathered community spends extra time together to explore its mystery and rejoice in its promise.

Please be aware that the Mass will be approximately 30 minutes longer than usual.
